and cannot see Him.

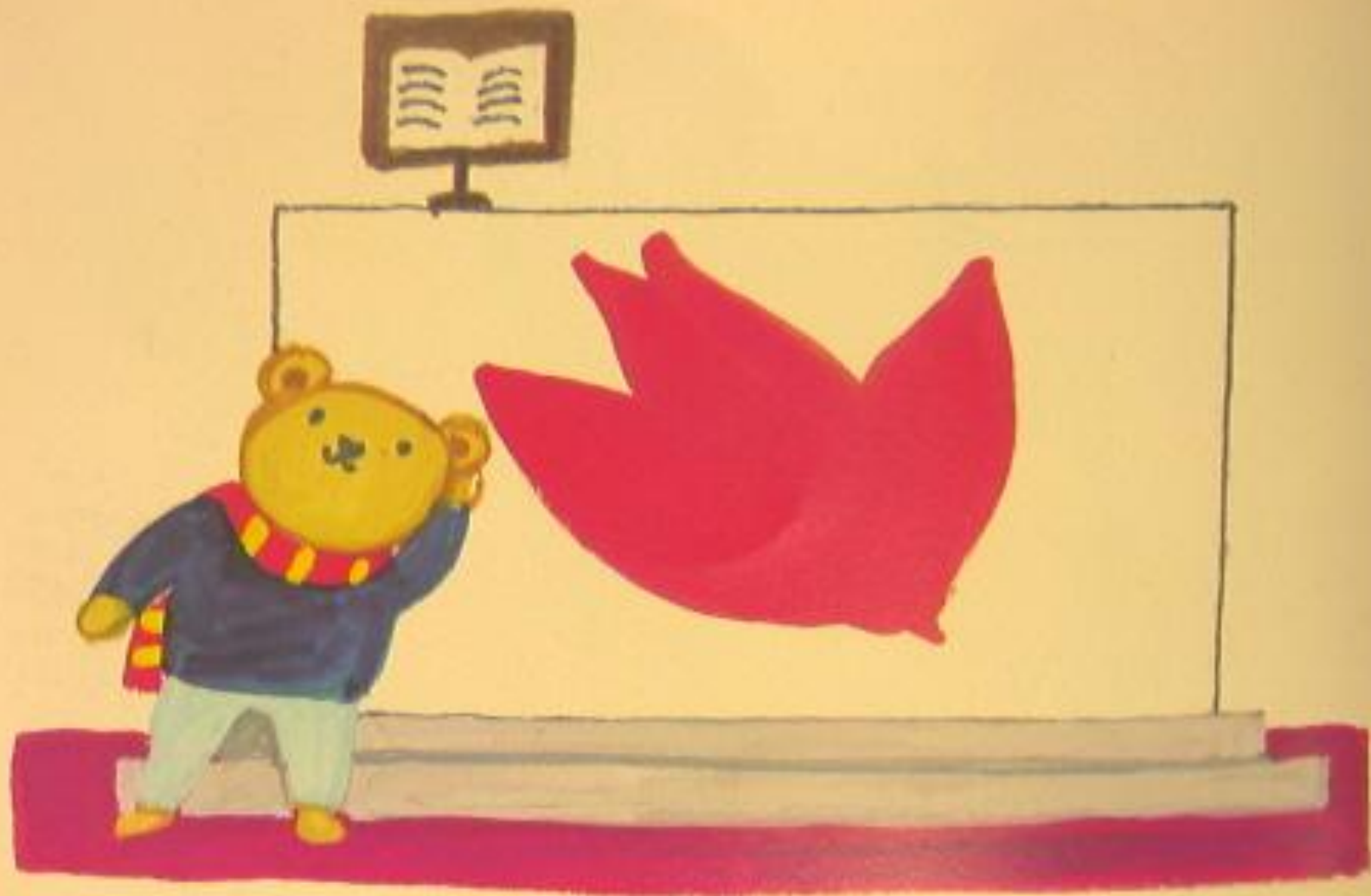




But he sees the Holy Spirit making people smile and dance.
